In her nearly 30 year legal career, Angela has litigated, investigated, and now mediates some of the nation's most sensitive and high profile employment and Title IX cases, including cases involving race and gender discrimination, sexual harassment, battery and assault, and retaliation.

Angela is a Distinguished Fellow with the National Academy of Distinguished Neutrals and is a fellow with the College of Labor & Employment Lawyers. She also is a past president of the Southern California Mediation Association (SCMA) and serves on the panel of mediators for the United States District Court, Central District of California. With a strong commitment to giving back and helping to develop the next generation of attorneys and mediators, Angela also is an Adjunct Professor for the Employment Mediation Clinic at USC Gould School of Law.

Beyond her work as an attorney, Angela has served on numerous public and non-profit sector boards, including as a member of the Los Angeles Community College Board of Trustees, the largest community college district in the country. Currently, she serves on the Board of Directors for the Los Angeles Urban League and the Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce.

Angela is a member of several bar associations, including being a lifetime member with both the John M. Langston Bar Association and Black Women Lawyers of Los Angeles. She also has served as the Langston Bar Association's representative to the Los Angeles County Bar Association (LACBA) Board of Trustees, and currently serves on the Executive Committee for the LACBA Labor & Employment Law Section.

Angela is a published author, speaker, and legal analyst, having appeared on such media outlets as ABC's Good Morning America, MSNBC, CNN, BBC, NPR, Court TV, and in the New York Times.

Angela hosts a weekly radio show on Tavis Smiley's KBLA Talk 1580 entitled *Legal Lens with Angela Reddock-Wright*, and recently published a book "*The Workplace Transformed: 7 Crucial Lessons from the Global Pandemic.*"
